Objectives

In 2008 the Alliance wanted to engage all key stakeholders in developing the future strategy of the Charity.

Ithaka was asked to assist in facilitating large groups of trustees, managers and stakeholders to gain their input into what the future strategy of the charity should be.

We were also asked to provide support to managers, who were responsible for implementing this strategy.

Outcome

From this objective, came the design and delivery of the Ithaka *Leadership Capability Programme*, which is recognised as accredited work based learning.

It also rewards individuals with a formal Coventry University Management Qualification.

The 6 day LCP is spread over 8 months and it focusses on the following areas;

- Developing effective working relationships
- → Improving Self and time Management
- → Developing leadership capability

- → Performance management through supervisions, delegation and coaching
- → Marketing and commercial awareness
- → Managing change

The results have been outstanding and LCP has been completed by 130 managers throughout England.
